OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub: Proposal of Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas (MoPNG) for general relaxation to Rule 161(iv)(b) of General Financial Rules (GFRs) for procurement of various items related to oil and gas sector which are not available in India through Global Tender Enquiry (GTE).

The undersigned is directed to refer to Ministry of Petroleum & Natural Gas (MoPNG) D.O. No. G-38011/37/2020-Fin.I (E-34977) dated 15.12.2020 wherein MoPNG has requested to grant a general relaxation for procurement of licensor mandated items from foreign vendors required for Oil and Gas installations through Global Tender Enquiry (GTE).

2. The proposal has been examined in Department of Expenditure and a general relaxation has been granted for two years from the date of issue of this OM for procurement of licensor mandated items from foreign vendors required for Oil and Gas installations through Global Tender Enquiry (GTE) with the approval of Secretary, MoPNG for safe operations of oil and gas PSUs. A written decision shall be issued by MoPNG in each case with copy to Department for Promotion of Industry & Internal Trade (DPIIT) and Cabinet Secretariat, specifying the item for which exemption is given. Further, MoPNG is requested to regularly engage with domestic industry to develop such items at the earliest.
