Subject: Relaxation on Global Tender Enquiry (GTE) under Rule 161(iv) of General Financial Rules (GFRs)- reg

The undersigned is directed to take reference of GTE Portal launched by the Secretary Coordination, Cabinet Secretariat deployed for the purpose of submitting applications for exemption under GFR 161 (iv), for processing by the administrative Ministries/ Departments, DPIIT, DoE and issuing exemptions by the Secretary Coordination. In this regard, a few observations have been outlined by this Department for enhancement of the portal and to undertake a comprehensive analysis of the proposals submitted by the Government Procuring Entities in an efficient manner.

2. While analysing the information furnished under the GTE Format by the procuring entities, it has come to light that some of the information is missing as per the existing GTE format. It is also noted from the Evaluation Criteria meant for DPIIT in the GTE Portal that a number of criteria have been mentioned for which the information needs to be provided by the procuring entities. As such, only after provision of these details, this department will be able in a position to make the comprehensive evaluation and thereby make recommendations to the Competent Authority. In view of it, it is requested that the requisite information may please be provided in the attached format on priority for further processing of the proposals submitted.
