The e-SamikSha is a web portal developed by NIC and is designed for monitoring and compliance mechanism to fast track the compliance of action-points/proposals/issues/ projects/schemes/target etc pending with various implementing departments of the State Government.

The system will enhance efficiency, bring transparency, reduce the need of protracted correspondence and improve the communication between government to government (G2G).
