Kropha today launched the Meghalaya e-SamikSha at the Conference Room, State Secretariat, Shillong in the presence of Dr. Shreerajan and Shri H. Marwein, Additional Chief Secretaries, Shri R.M Mishra and Smti R.V. Suchiang, Principal Secretaries, and other senior government officials.

The e-SamikSha is a web portal developed by NIC and is designed for monitoring and compliance mechanism to fast track the compliance of Action-Points, proposals, issues, projects, schemes as target etc pending with various implementing departments of the State Government.

The system will enhance efficiency, bring transparency, reduce the need of protracted correspondence and improve the communication between government to government (G2G). To familiarize the working of the portal, a Presentation on e-SamikSha online system is given by Dr. Shubhag Chand, Director, Cabinet Secretariat, Informatics Division, New Delhi.
